The Akron Township Board has received a letter from Rural Development in response to the Pre-Application for funding of a potential water project within Akron Township. The township is eligible for financial assistance from Rural Development of a loan for \$855,000 and a grant of \$245,000. The loan term would be 40 years at the intermediate interest rate.

The potential water project was pending upon Wisner's approval of their water project, which has passed on Monday, June 21, 2010. Akron Township is waiting upon petitions from residents within the proposed water system district before any determinations will be made.

April 15, 2010

Akron Township Board is considering a water system project within the township. Akron Township had paid Civil Engineering Consultants \$1,000 to do a preliminary project report for the cost of a water project. The quote that was given is \$1.1 million. The mapping of the project consisted of the following:

- M-25 from Vassar Rd. to Thomas Rd.
- Vassar Rd. from M-25 to Bay Park Rd.
- All of Bay Park Area
- From Bay Park Area extending to and covering the Cenzer Subdivision
- From Cenzer Subdivision extending to and covering the Sunset Bay Community
- Extending from Sunset Bay to Sunglow and covering the Sunglow Community

The Akron Township Board has also applied for a grant with Rural Development to seek grant money to help cover the cost of the water project. The board is waiting to hear from Rural Development on both issues.

The opportunity for Akron Township to receive water is pending Wisner Townships' approval of their water project. At that time, Akron Township Board will consider the following factors:

- Grant money awarded to Akron Twp.
- Cost bids from other engineers as well as CEC
- Full application to Rural Development
- Environmental Study Report
- Petitions from residents within the proposed water system district

This water project is a step-by-step process that takes time, in which we do not always get the information as quick as one anticipates. For a month-by-month progress on Akron Townships' proposed water project, refer to the monthly minutes until the next update.
